**V Attestation**

I, the undersigned Official Veterinarian, do hereby certify that:

1. Finland or a zone of Finland where the pigs originate from is, in accordance with European Union legislation and the Terrestrial Animal Health Code of World Organization for Animal Health (WOAH), free from foot and mouth disease (FMD), classical swine fever (CSF) and African swine fever (ASF) and in accordance with the Terrestrial Animal Health Code of WOAH free from Aujeszky's disease (AD), transmissible gastroenteritis (TGE) and porcine reproductive and respiratory syndrome (PRRS);
2. the pigs were born and raised in Finland;
3. the pigs originate from premises, where for the past 12 months prior to departure have been no clinical cases of swine vesicular disease (SVD), brucellosis, leptospirosis, atrophic rhinitis nor trichinosis;
4. the pigs have been kept isolated with no contact to animals of lower health status for a period of 30 days prior to departure;
5. the pigs have, within the 30 day quarantine period prior to exportation, been tested with negative results for the following diseases using test methods as indicated in part III of the certificate:
  - a. brucellosis
  - b. Aujeszky's disease
  - c. TGE
  - d. PRRS
6. the pigs were found to be free of any clinical signs of infectious or contagious diseases to which the species is susceptible;
7. the pigs to be exported have been treated at the quarantine facility for internal and external parasites as indicated in the table of part IV of the certificate; and
8. the export quarantine facilities, transport containers, vehicles, vessels and aircraft for transportation of the pigs must be cleaned and disinfected.
