### III Attestation

I, the undersigned Official Veterinarian do hereby certify that the processed animal protein described above:

- 1) was produced in the processing plant indicated in point I.7 of the certificate that has been approved and is under the supervision of the competent authority:
  - a. in a region which has not had an indigenous case of BSE; or
  - b. contains cervid material derived only from cervid subject to a ban on feeding ruminant derived meat-and-bone-meal and greaves to ruminants;
- 2) is suitable for use as feed or feed material;
- 3) was produced from raw materials which were treated in accordance with the relevant European Union and national legislation on animal by-products;
- 4) contains cervid processed animal protein as the only material of animal origin;
- 5) was heated to a minimum internal temperature of 80 °C;
- 6) was not commingled with or contaminated with material derived from other animal species than cervid animals or with ruminant meat-and-bone-meal or greaves from APHIS-defined controlled or undetermined risk countries, APHIS-defined SRMs or mechanically separated meat derived from the skull and vertebral column of bovines over 12 months of age from undetermined risk regions<sup>1)</sup>; and
- 7) the processed animal protein was handled, produced, packed and stored under sanitary conditions in accordance with the relevant European Union and national legislation.
