**4. Certificate of the fitness of the goods for human consumption**

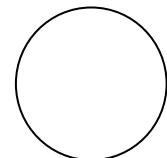
1. The export of whole egg powder, liquid whole egg, egg albumen powder and other food products processed from eggs are derived from healthy birds at farms not infected with infectious diseases, and were produced at establishments approved by the central state veterinary service of the exporting country and are under its constant supervision.
2. Eggs for processing are derived from farms and administrative territories free from infectious diseases, including:
  - African swine fever – during the last 3 years in the territory of the country;
  - Foot-and-mouth disease – during the last 12 months in the administrative territory (state, province, land, district etc.);
  - Omrnithosis (psittacosis), avian infectious laryngotracheitis, avian infectious bronchitis, avian encephalomyelitis, Newcastle disease and other infectious paramyxovirales with domestic poultry, fowl cholera – during the last 12 months in the administrative territory (State, province, land, etc.).
3. Exported into the Russian Federation foodstuff made from eggs have no modified organoleptic parameters, are not contained by Salmonella or other bacterial infection agents, was not treated with colouring substances, ionizing or ultra-violet rays, do not contain natural or synthetic estrogenic and hormonal substances, thyreostatics, pesticides and other drugs.
4. The delivered foodstuff made from eggs or containing products from processed eggs was duly processed to guarantee the absence or pathogens.
5. The egg products are recognised by state service to be fit for human consumption and for sale without restrictions.
6. Microbiological, chemical-toxicological and radiological characteristics of egg products correspond to actual veterinary and sanitary requirements of the Russian Federation.
7. Single-use containers and packaging material correspond to hygienic requirements.
8. The means of transport are treated and prepared in correspondence with the rules approved in the exporting country.
